
Getting Started With Dragon

- Dragon Medical One is a voice recognition platform that seamlessly integrates into Epic to help providers dictate notes and navigate around the system.
- Speak into Dragon through your mobile device or stand alone microphone; your speech is then transcribed securely and in real time directly into Epic.

Login to Dragon

- Step One – When you are logged into Epic the Dragon button is in the top left. Click the Dragon button.

Login to Dragon

- Step Two – Once you are logged in a new menu, a Dragon Bar, should appear.
- Dragon Bar – This bar is used to start/stop dictation, as well as to configure and control how the system creates text.

Microphone Button

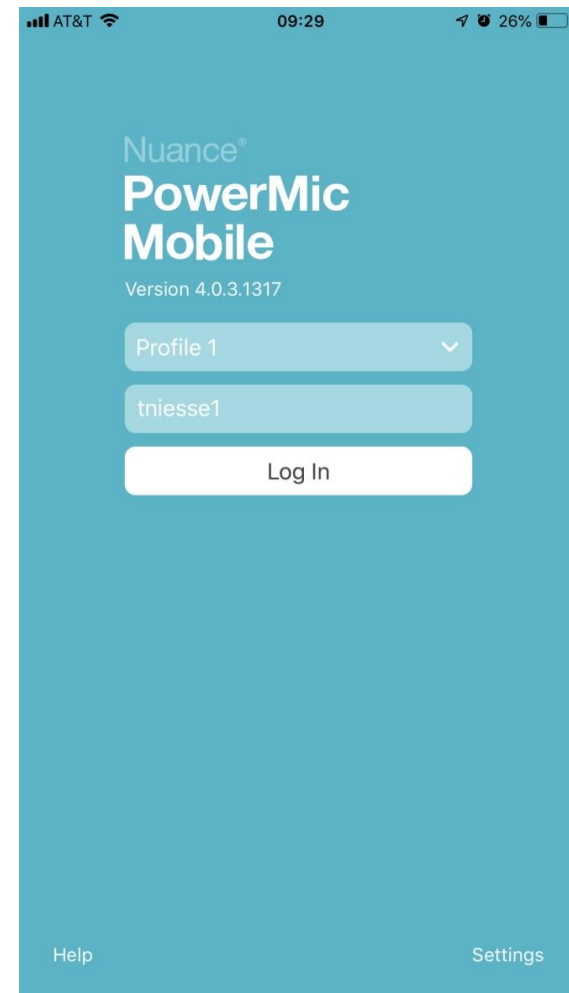
Appearance will change depending on whether or not the microphone is paired with Dragon and in use.

Pairing Dragon and Mobile Device

- Pairing between Dragon and your microphone should happen automatically
- Please refer to the Getting Started Tipsheet if having difficulty
- The Dragon Bar should **ALWAYS** be opened **PRIOR** to launching the microphone

Pairing Dragon and Mobile Device

- Once Dragon and your Mobile device are paired your Dragon Bar Microphone icon will turn red from orange
- Red (Dragon Bar) – means the microphone is OFF, click to turn on



- White (Mobile Device) – means the microphone is OFF, click to turn on



Pairing Dragon and Mobile Device

- Click the microphone icon to turn OFF/ON your microphone
- Green (Dragon Bar) – means the microphone is ON, click to turn off




- Blue (Mobile Device) – means the microphone is ON, click to turn off



Dictating a Note

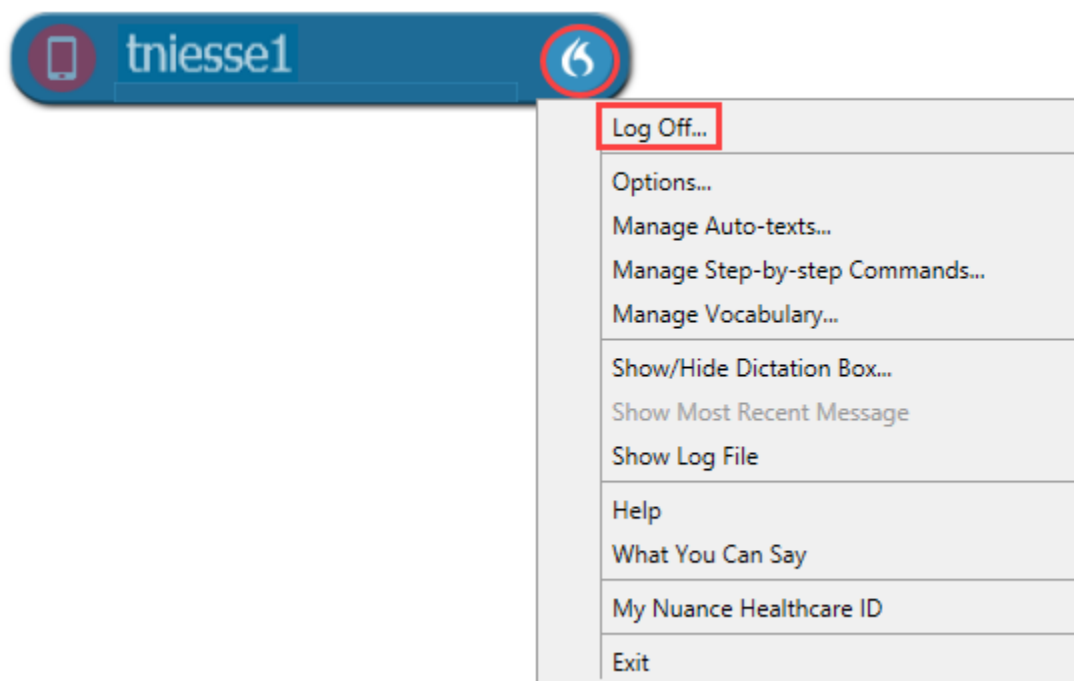
- Congratulations!
