

ED Narrator Tool Bar activities

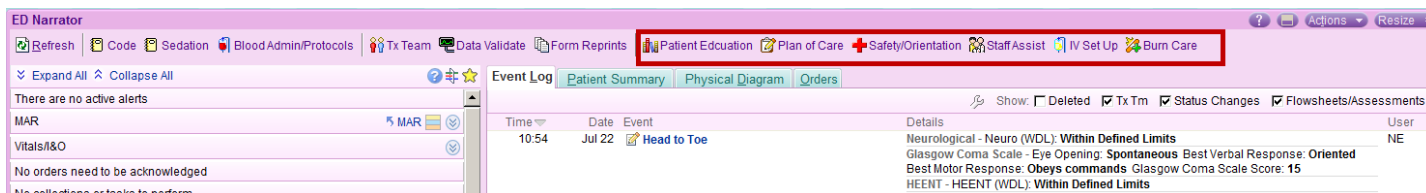
Documentation that is found in the tool bar within the ED Narrator

There have been several pieces of documentation added to the tool bar within the ED Narrator. Some of this documentation contributes minutes to the Facility Charge Calculator, some of it drops supply charges, and some of it replicates existing pieces found in the legacy system.



Try It Out

1. Open a patient's chart and go to the **ED Narrator**.
2. The tool bar is found in the middle of the screen:



3. The **Patient Education** activity is used to document patient/family education performed outside of the discharge process. For example, triage family education or education about disease process for the patient who is being admitted. It will also drop minutes in the Facility Charge Calculator for nursing care time:

This documentation should be done by the nurse/clinical technician documenting the procedure. This will also drop minutes in the Facility Charge Calculator for Nursing Care Time:
