1. **Advanced Practice Provider and Residents-** From the **Admit navigator**, place the appropriate admission order for your patient (**Admit to Inpatient/ ADT1**) and then click **Accept**:





3. Once you are finished with the Admit order and the BPA, click **Sign Orders**:


4. You will be asked for a **Cosigner** for this order so that the Attending provider will get a reminder for the Certification order:



5. Once the patient class has been changed to Inpatient in Keene and fed back into Epic, Attending providers will see a reminder to sign the certification order from within the patient's chart:
- The procedure to change the patient class can take 10-15 minutes; it is not an immediate process
6. When the ED Attending logs into the patient's chart, a BPA will appear reminding them that the Certification order still needs to be placed. By clicking on the **Click Here to Place the Certification Hyperlink**, the user will be jumped directly into the Manager Orders activity:



7. The next BPA that appears will directly place the order. Click **Sign**:
