

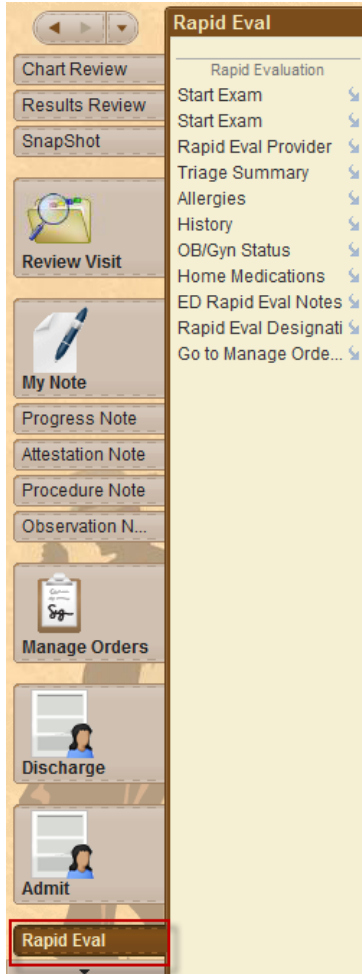
RAP Workflow

When ED Providers are located in triage and are working as RAP Providers, there is a specific navigator to complete this workflow.



Try It Out

1. Log in to Hyperspace and open the **Rapid Eval** navigator:



2. The first section allows you to document your **Exam Start** time. Manually change the time to reflect your actual exam start time and then click **Exam Started**:

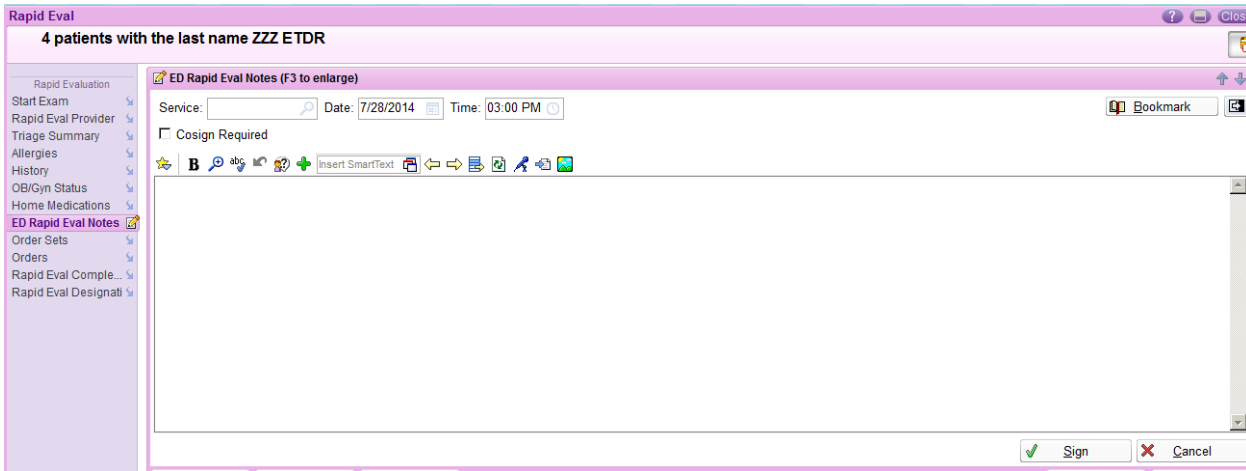
3. Next, you can free text your name as the Rapid Eval **Provider**:

- The following 5 sections (**Triage Summary, Allergies, History, OB/Gyn Status, and Home Medications**) are there to view documentation entered by the Triage Nurse and also to enter any new information provided by the patient.
- The ED Rapid Eval Note is where you can document your initial assessment of the patient and the initial plan of treatment:



- Next, document a recommended **Designation** for the patient:



- Finally, when you click on **Go to Manage Orders**, it will jump you out into the Manage Orders section of the chart. The benefit of this is that you will be able to easily see the orders placed via a NIPO by the Triage Nurses, reducing the risk of placing duplicate orders.
